School Choice explained

Our School Choice Programme allows students to choose where they would like to be placed for their Irish experience.

Students should select 3 schools from our School Choice list, in order of preference. Students will be placed (according to availability) in one of their selected choices from the school list.

Although every care is taken in order to fulfil the student's request, please note that schools may run out of places, particularly in case of a late application, so the choice cannot be guaranteed.

In the unlikely event of all 3 schools requested being full, the student will be offered the choice of a different school from the above list or a place on the regular InterStudies High School Classic programme.

Students can apply for the School Choice programme for one or two full academic years. Not all schools accept students for part-year programmes.

School life in Ireland

In Ireland, students attend primary education from the age of 6-12, secondary education from the age of 12-18, and tertiary education from the age of 18+.

The School Day

The School Day in Ireland starts around 9:00 and finishes at around 15:30, though this may vary slightly from school to school. Each class lasts around 40 minutes and students usually change classrooms for each class.

The Junior Cycle

In the Junior Cycle, students will usually study a total of nine to thirteen subjects as they settle into life at secondary school. At the end of Junior Cycle, students will sit the Junior Certificate exam.

The Transition Year

Transition Year is a one-year programme between the Junior Cycle and the two-year Leaving Certificate programme, designed to act as a bridge between the Junior Certificate and Leaving Certificate programmes. The TY is a great opportunity for students looking for a cultural experience. Each individual school designs its own TY programme, within set guidelines, and if placed in TY students will experience a wide range of subjects as well as the chance to take part in activities which may range from work experience to projects, trips and excursions.

TY students have a great opportunity to experience different aspects of school life in Ireland, mixing with local and other international students on trips as well as in the classroom. Please note that there is an extra expense for taking part in TY, charged by the school to contribute towards costs of trips and activities. TY fees are not included in the programme fee.

The Senior Cycle

Students in 5th or 6th year will be studying towards the leaving certificate.

Senior students will study 6-8 subjects, which usually includes English, Maths and Religion, as well as a range of optional subjects which may include subjects like other languages, Sciences, Social Sciences, Music, Technology or Arts. Students choose their options from the subjects available at the individual school.

Schools will not expect international students to study the Irish language. Some schools put on extra English classes as an alternative, while others let students choose a different subject.











Extracurricular activities at school

Sports, music and getting together is a big part of life in Ireland — and this applies in Irish schools as well! Participating in activities offered by the school is a great way to get involved and make local friends.

Sports

Sports are an important part of school life at Irish schools. Most schools have teams in traditional Irish sports as well as some of the international sports you will know from home.

Clubs, bands and choirs

Most schools also offer a variety of clubs and other activities at lunchtime and after school, which can range from the opportunity to join the school's choirs, bands or various clubs to other enrichment activities. Music and singing is important in Ireland, and it is also a great way to get together.

School uniform

Wearing a uniform is compulsory in Irish schools.

The uniform mostly consists of plain items of clothing, such as white shirt or blouse, dark skirt or trousers, plain socks and dark shoes plus school specific items such as a school blazer and tie. Students are therefore advised to bring plain clothing from home. School specific items will have to be purchased after arrival.

Many schools operate schemes with some uniform items being available second hand, although students will have to expect to purchase the uniform items from new. The cost of a school uniform is normally in the region of a regular full set of clothes, including a formal blazer and tie.


